<p>RANCHO LEVEL I</p> <p>No response - unresponsive to all stimuli</p>	<p>RANCHO LEVEL II*</p> <p>Generalized response - inconsistent and nonspecific responses</p>	<p>RANCHO LEVEL III</p> <p>Localized response - inconsistent responses directly related to the stimulus</p>	<p>RANCHO LEVEL IV</p> <p>Confused and agitated - alert with slowed processing, aggressive or bizarre behaviors</p>
<p>RANCHO LEVEL V</p> <p>Confused and nonagitated - distractable, responds to simple commands</p>	<p>RANCHO LEVEL VI</p> <p>Confused and appropriate - inconsistently oriented, appropriate responses to simple commands</p>	<p>RANCHO LEVEL VII</p> <p>Automatic and appropriate - appropriate and oriented in hospital and home, impaired insight, judgment and emotional control</p>	<p>RANCHO LEVEL VIII</p> <p>Purposeful and appropriate - oriented, learns new material, impaired tolerance for stress</p>
