Same Day Services (Primary Care & Mental Health): Veterans with a need for care right away will have it addressed the same day or, if after hours, by the next day.

*Individuals with Other Than Honorable discharges may be eligible for up to 90-days of mental health care

Primary Care – Mental Health Integration (PCMHI)

- Mental health clinicians embedded in Primary Care clinics
- Services:
 - Same-day intakes & referrals
 - Brief therapy for mild to moderate MH concerns
 - ▶ Up to six 30-minute sessions
 - Referral to other mental health services
- Locations: most VA Primary Care clinics
- Referral: Access through Primary Care Provider (PCP) at visit; no scheduled appointment necessary.



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Behavioral Health Interdisciplinary Program (BHIP)

- General outpatient mental health services in interdisciplinary teams
 - medication management
 - Individual therapy
 - group therapy
 - Couples therapy
- ▶ Locations: ALM, FTOPC, NCFC, SBOPC, KMC, VOPC
- Telemental health: smart phone, tablet, computer, or partner clinic
- Referral: Consult from Primary Care or other provider



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Peer Support Specialists

- Veterans with lived experience of MH/SU concerns
- Foster hope and combat stigma
- Help engage Veterans and bridge with treatment team
- Help with transition between programs

TeleMental Health

- Mental health medication or therapy via technology
 - Avoid traffic/travel time, parking, transportation concerns, hospital stress
 - Can be alternative if not able to make appointments in person
- VA Video Connect (VVC)
 - Uses a computer, tablet, or smartphone from anywhere with sufficient internet or cellular data connection.
- Telehealth through clinic
 - Go in-person to partner clinic and see VA provider

Specialty MH & Recovery Services

PTSD Clinical Team (PCT)

- Psychotherapy for PTSD related to military trauma (combat, non-combat, military sexual trauma)
- Time-limited, evidence-based therapies
 - individual therapy
 - group therapy
 - couples therapy
- Location: Frank Tejeda Outpatient Clinic, (210) 699-2120
- Referral: Consult from Primary Care or mental health provider





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Substance Abuse Treatment Program

- Outpatient:
 - Twice-weekly therapy groups
 - Medication-assisted treatment
 - Location: ALM (1E), KMC, and other outpatient clinics
- Residential: 28+ day residential treatment program
 - interdisciplinary group therapy
 - case management
 - medication management
 - Location: Villa Serena, (210) 321-2700










Psychosocial Rehabilitation & Recovery Center (PRRC)

- Stepping Stones: ongoing group-based program for Veterans with severe mood disorders (e.g., Bipolar Disorder, Major Depression with psychosis) and psychotic disorders
 - group and individual therapy, recreation activities, recovery support
- > **STARR:** intensive MH outpatient program; serves Veterans with most diagnoses
 - ▶ 10-day group therapy program, 9-2:30 daily
- Location: ALM 1E clinic, (210) 949-9791
- Referral: Consult from mental health provider





Other Psychosocial Rehabilitation Programs

- Specialty programs for severe mood disorders (e.g., Bipolar Disorder, Major Depression with psychosis) and psychotic disorders
 - ▶ PRIME Psychiatry Clinic
 - Medication management, social work, and individual therapy
 - Intensive Community Mental Health Recovery (ICMHR/formerly MHICM)
 - Weekly home visits from interdisciplinary team (e.g., case management, medication assistance, and individual therapy)
- Location: ALM 1C, (210) 949-9794
- Referral: Consult from mental health provider



Emergency Department & Inpatient Mental Health Unit

- Acute psychiatric and safety concerns
- 24/7 service at Audie Murphy VA Hospital
 - Walk-in access
- Inpatient MH: locked unit
 - Interdisciplinary, recovery-focused approach
 - Brief duration, focus on discharge to community and connection with ongoing care



Domiciliary Care for Homeless Veterans ("The Dom" / DCHV)

 90+ day residential homelessness & employment program at Villa Serena.

Services:

- Case management
- Group therapy
- Assistance finding housing
- Compensated Work Therapy (assistance finding employment)
- Location: Villa Serena, (210) 321-2700
- Referral: Consult from Primary Care or mental health provider



Compensated Work Therapy

- Level of support varies by program and needs
- Resume support, job connections, interview skills, liaison with employer
- Supported Employment
- Transitional Work
- Community Based Employment Support
- Location: Community-based & Bluff Creek Clinic, (210) 949-9010
- **Referral:** consult from PCP or MH provider



Neuropsychology

- Dementia & Cognitive Concerns
 - Comprehensive assessments
 - Support groups (including caregivers)
 - ▶ **Location:** ALM 1E, (210) 617-5121
 - **Referral:** consult from PCP or other provider
- Traumatic Brain Injury
 - Assessment and rehabilitative services
 - ► **Location:** ALM Polytrauma Clinic



Vet Centers

- Readjustment Centers
- Separate records/eligibility from VHA
 - combat service, Military Sexual Trauma
- Mostly Veteran clinicians/staff
- Same-day/walk-in intakes
 - Evening/weekend hours








Community Resources


Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic at Endeavors

- Serves mostly Post-9/11 Veterans (any discharge)
 - Also serves family members (apart from Vet)
 - Offer childcare services
- Individual, group, couples, children/family therapy
 - EBP model (12-24 sessions)
- Limited medication management (refer back to VA or others)
- Life skills & Wellness groups
- Community education programs
- Sliding scale fee + insurance
- Also offers teleMH care



Ecumenical Center

- Individual, couples, family therapy, parenting classes
 - Veteran-specific grant: offer on sliding scale (also insurance)
- Support groups
 - Grief/loss (SOLOS)
 - Recovery International
- Optional faith-based services
- Therapeutic arts groups
 - Monthly Poetry Writing Circle


