VHMAC-ST Meeting Minutes (21 Sep 2022)

I. Call to Order

Council Chair Dr. David A. La Pointe called to order the regular meeting of the Veterans' Healthy Minds Advisory Council South Texas, at 1104 on 21 Sep 2022, at AACOG Headquarters, 2700 NE Loop 410, SATX 78217, and via Zoom video/tele-conference.

Dr. La Pointe called the council to order at 1102.

Dr. Davis introduced a Resident “Fellow” who is new to the VA hospital who is sitting in as our guest today.

II. Membership Updates: New Members: Priscilla Cerbin-Cantu.

We have 24 members, 21 voting members, 3 non-voting members (from VA staff), 18 veterans, 6 community partners, 6 remaining original members of the council (Dr. Davis, Dr. La Pointe, Karah Smith, Kevin Crozier, Carlos Acosta, Col. Lisa Firmin), 15 inactive members (those who want to remain connected to the council but cannot attend meetings).

III. Approval/Review of Previous Minutes/Current Agenda

Dr. La Pointe motioned to accept previous meeting minutes from the last two months. Motion seconded by Kevin Crozier and approved by all.

GUEST SPEAKER – No Guest Speaker this month.

IV. Old Business

VHMACST Veteran Resilience and Recovery Operation/ Collaborative. Dr. Davis – no new relevant updates this month for the group. (OPEN)

VHMACST – VA Mental Health National Call – Dr. Davis reported the national council call this month was particularly good. She wants to share the “TEAMS” recording with us and is contacting the National VAMH Council to arrange it. She highlighted some of the input from the other councils around the country and thought we might focus our efforts, resulting in innovative ideas/programs we could use locally. Another council organized a “Recovery Night” where Veterans talk about their recovery experiences, providing “hope” for other veterans. They also started a program, sending out cards to veterans on the holidays. They also had another program where they had “washers” that were sent out. (OPEN)

VHMACST – VA Mental Health Executive Council - Dr. Davis stated these are mandated meetings; every VA must have a VA Mental Health Executive Council of the different offices of the mental health services. They are making internal revision on how they are going to utilize this council as they move forward in a more meaningful way. (OPEN)

VHMACST – Strategic Planning Sub-Committee – Dr. Davis stated that she should not be the committee chair as she is a VA representative and that another council member should be facilitating/filling this role. She said she might have a template that could be useful moving forward and will get that to us ASAP. Amelia Peacock volunteered to chair this committee.

VHMACST— Women Veterans Sub-Committee. We need a volunteer to take over as Committee Chair for the Woman Veterans Sub-committee because of Col Lisa Firmin’s departure. Interested persons – please contact one of the officers ASAP. (OPEN)

UNACCOMPANIED BURIAL MEMORIAL SERVICE - Ed Thomas gave us an update on the program. We currently have funds for two more months for arrangements. The florist he’s working with is going to add a single red rose to the arrangement for each Veteran being honored at each function, He discussed the need for us to transform into a “non-profit” organization so we can disperse fund appropriately and have our donors able to take tax credits for their generosity. (OPEN)

WEBSITE/COMMUNICATIONS – Kevin Crosier briefed us on the current status of the website. We are approaching 600,000 hits on our site! He gave us information on the variety of information available on the platform and asked all to take a look and provide feedback on improvements/recommendations to aide Veterans and family Members.

V. New Business

GUEST SPEAKER: No Guest Speaker this month

VHMACST Overview Discussion – Dr. La Pointe highlighted what the VHMACST is, what we are supposed to be doing (helping Veteran’s and Family Members navigate the VA Mental Health system and assist them in any way we are able. He stated, “maybe we should concentrate our efforts on the topics that are most frequently being reviewed on the website.” He explained the council’s participation in producing packages that resulted in two Family Member’s receiving grants for college. The letters to the individuals selected *specifically cited the verbiage we submitted as a main reason for their selection.*

National Defense Service Medal Termination – The letter describing the process for ending the awarding of this medal was discussed and a short article will be included in these minutes as an attachment.

The VHMACST is a part of a committee that assists in reviewing VA documents to ensure they are clear for Veteran's and family members to easily read and understand. If you are interested in participating with this council contact the Chair who is the only council representative currently serving.

Dr, La Pointe reviewed the "Burn Pit Registry Program." Flyer will be attached to minutes.

There was a lengthy discussion about the "elimination" altogether or possibly only having individual Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) classes for men. This is something the council feels strongly about and believes males in IPV situations are no less traumatized than females who endure similar attacks. We feel like we need to respond to what may or may not be happening with this program. There were a variety of responses and Dr. Davis and Dr. La Pointe agreed that inviting the new person who just took over this program to the next VHMACST meeting would be an excellent choice. Dr. Davis has provided her information and we will contact her to request her at our next meeting.

UPDATE: Ms. Suzanne M. McEndree (IPV Program Coordinator) will not be able to join us for our October meeting as she is already committed to another engagement. She will, however, be our Guest Speaker at our November meeting. We look forward to speaking with her!

There was a brief discussion about how someone could recognize outstanding performance by a nurse in the VA system. Dr. Davis was asked and provided information on the "daisynomination.org" program.

The end of presenting the National Defense Service Medal has big implications for future Veterans. America will shift back into "peace time" conditions as far as the military is concerned, and for VA purposes.

Future Veterans who enter the military after October 1, will not be eligible for Non Service Connected Pension.

You need 90 days of wartime service (for Vets pre Sep 1980 it was one day for enlisted and there is a 1981 date for officers the exact information is at the link below) to be eligible and you need to meet 24 consecutive months of service, other than dishonorable discharge and be 65 or older. HTTP

Enroll in Burn Pit Registry

VFW encourages all veterans who participated in eligible operations to join the VA's Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry.

To register, visit www.veteran.mobilehealth.va.gov/AHBurnPitRegistry.

Veterans who have not filed a claim for these conditions or had their medical records and previous VA disability claims reviewed should contact a VA-accredited VFW service officer for free help.

To find a nearby VFW service officer, visit www.vfw.org/service-officers.

Veterans of the following operations are eligible to apply:

- Operation Desert Storm
- Operation Desert Shield
- Operation New Dawn
- Operation Iraqi Freedom
- Operation Enduring Freedom

Those eligible are asked to join the registry even if:

- They do not believe they were exposed to specific airborne hazards.
- They are not experiencing symptoms or illnesses believed to be related to exposure.
- They have not filed a VA claim for compensation or applied for VA health care.

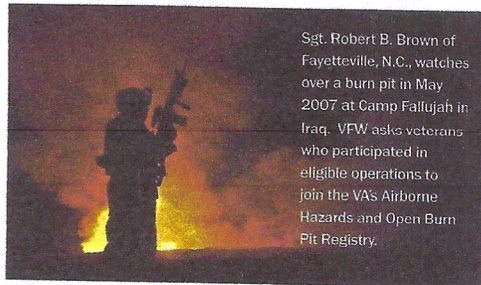

- They are still on active duty or have returned to military service.

VA presumptive conditions for burn pit, or particulate matter exposure, include:

- Asthma
- Rhinitis
- Sinusitis

Conditions associated with burn pit exposure are associated with:

- Asthma
- Emphysema
- Chronic bronchitis
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disorder, or COPD

Biden Signs VFW-Supported Bills into Law

President Joe Biden in June signed into law three bills that aim to improve veterans' care at VA health care facilities.

VFW Washington Office Executive Director Bob Wallace and VFW National Legislative Deputy Director Tammy Barlet attended the White House ceremony when Biden signed the legislation.

Here are the three laws backed by VFW:

- The *Dr. Kate Hendricks Thomas SERVICE Act (P.L. 117-133)*, which expands eligibility for VA mammography screenings to veterans who served in areas that are associated with the use of burn pits. The bill is named in honor of Marine Corps veteran Kate Hendricks Thomas, who died of breast cancer in March 2022. She served as an officer in the Iraq War.
- The *Making Advances in Mammography and Medical Options for Veterans Act (P.L. 117-135)*, also known as the *MAMMO for Veterans Act*, requires VA to devise a plan that could improve mammography, create a pilot program to address the need for veterans to receive mammograms in areas where the test is not available and collaborate with the National Cancer Institute to give VA patients the chance to access clinical trials.
- The *Strengthening Oversight for Veterans Act of 2021 (P.L. 117-136)*, which gives the VA Office of the

Inspector General the authority to subpoena witnesses connected or formerly connected to the VA for testimony regarding investigations.

Biden acknowledged the work of veteran service organizations, including VFW, during the White House ceremony. "I want to thank each one of you personally," Biden said. "You are the most valuable thing veterans have. We owe you a great deal, and the families owe you."
