## What We Do

VR Services provides programs that match and support work ready Veterans in competitive jobs within the local business community. We also offer supported services for those Veterans in need of intensive assistance and vocational support.

Vocational Supports Include:

- Employment Planning
- Job Search Assistance
- Identifying Transferable / Marketable Skills
- Resume and Cover Letter Writing
- Completing Applications
- Interview Coaching & Preparation
- Interpersonal Skills Training
- Developing Healthy Work Routines
- Job Coaching
- On-the-job Supports
- Advocacy Assistance
- Community Integration

## Available Programs

**Community Based Employment Services (CBES)** provides a range of services (see listed vocational supports section) leading to meaningful competitive employment. Veterans receive follow-along assistance as needed.



**Supported Employment (SE)** provides individual placement and support that focuses on the Veteran's choice for employment in the community. Veterans receive continuous support as they adjust to competitive employment.

**Transitional Work (TW)** provides rehabilitation for Veterans through a combination of work experience and therapy. TW helps Veterans return to competitive employment by assisting them through contracted work assignments. These opportunities increase Veterans' self-efficacy, marketable skills, and capacity to sustain the demands of work.

## Admission Requirements

- Veteran eligible for VA health care
- Referral (consult) from VA Privileged Provider
- Be cleared for participation
- Must want to secure and maintain meaningful community-based competitive employment

VR Services partners with Texas Department of Assistive and Rehabilitation Services, Texas Veterans Commission, and other community agencies.

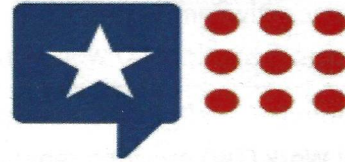
