# How to apply for an adapted housing grant

## How do I prepare before starting my application?

- Find out if you're eligible for an SAH or SHA grant
- Make sure you have the information listed here

## You'll need these documents to apply:

- Social Security number
- VA file or claim number (if you have one)

## How do I apply?

You can apply online right now on eBenefits.

When you go to the eBenefits website, you may need to sign in with your **DS Logon** account to access the application. If you don't have a **DS Logon** account, you can register for one there.

#### By mail

Fill out an Application in Acquiring Specially Adapted Housing or Special Home Adaptation Grant (VA Form 26-4555).

Mail the completed application to your nearest regional loan center.
